## Diversity Audit

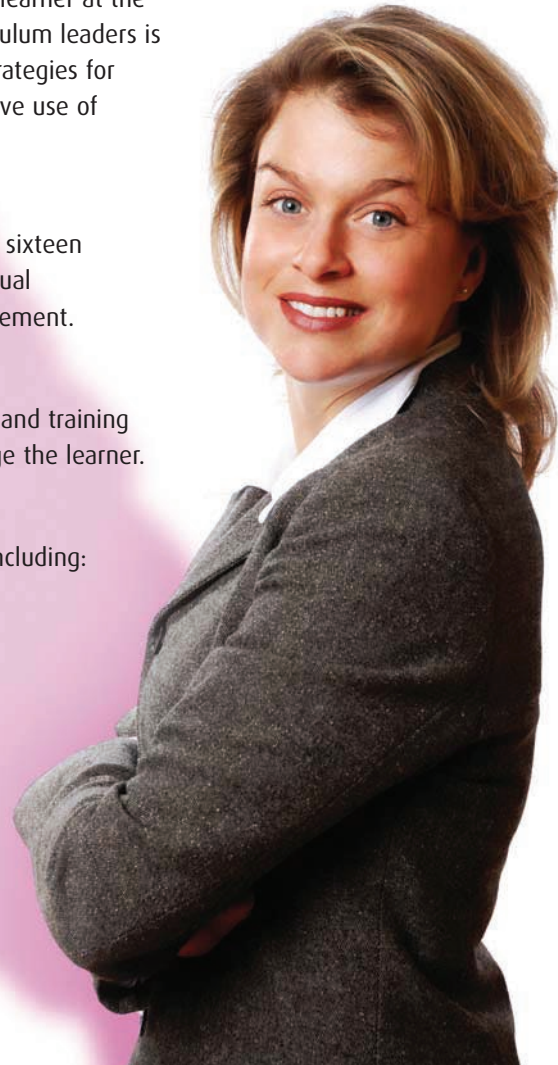
