

# Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement



Tenet Education Services Limited (Tenet) is a not for profit professional procurement consultancy who are owned by a registered charity owned by the Further Education Sector. Tenet exists to generate savings and efficiencies while improving value for our Customers through a wide range of procurement support services.

Tenet is committed to facilitating the acquisition of goods and services for its Customers in FE, HE, Schools, Academies and similar organisations, without causing harm to others.

This Statement is designed to satisfy the requirements of Part 6 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, by informing our Customers and other key stakeholders about Tenet and its policy with respect to modern slavery, human trafficking, forced and bonded labour and labour rights violations in its supply chains.

Tenet's turnover is below the threshold for businesses required to publish a statement under the Act. Tenet considers that the value of Customer spend we are involved in warrants a statement on the risks inherent in our Customers supply chains and the steps we are taking to address them. Our procurement takes place in England and our suppliers are predominately UK and EU based.

Compliance with the Modern Slavery Act is embedded into tender processes we undertake on behalf of our Customers. Tenet is committed to working with our Customers supply chains and working towards greater transparency and responsibility towards people working with them.

Tenet will be undertaking companywide training during the month of July 2019 to ensure that all members of the Procurement Team hold a qualification in Ethical Procurement as delivered by the Chartered Institute of Procurement and Supply (CIPS).
